MOSAIC 2024 SUBMISSION DEADLINES:

August 1st @ 4pm (to be included in an EARLY BIRD draw for one of four Mosaic Card Pkgs)

September 4th @ 4pm (for inclusion on the 2024 Exhibition Poster)

September 12th @ 4pm FINAL SUBMISSION DEADLINE

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

*Note that we can only accept artwork submissions with dimensions of exactly 6"x 6".

- Masonite tiles are available free of charge through our office, or you can use a surface or material of your choice. All mediums are welcome, including paint, photography, felting, plaster, collage etc. (note that the use of Gesso as an absorbent primer is highly recommended if you are using Masonite tiles).
- If your artwork is selected as a card or framed by a purchaser, a border of 1/8" around the edges of the tile will be lost please consider this when creating and signing your submission.
- Watercolour and photography submissions must be attached to a flat surface in order to prevent edges from being compromised as a result of being displayed upright for the duration of the Exhibition. Artists are invited to attach their work prior to submission, and otherwise we will attach the art to a Masonite tile at our office using double-sided, acid-free archival tape.
- All artworks MUST be accompanied by a signed submission form, and a separate submission form is required for EACH individual artist in a group. *Original works only*.
- Submissions received after the final deadline of September 12th cannot be accepted for 2024 and will be set aside for our 27th Mosaic in 2025.
- NOTE: All submissions become the property of CMHA Halifax-Dartmouth Branch, which reserves the right to not accept artwork that is overtly offensive and/or not aligned with our Organizational Mission & Values.
