<u>Community Service Worker – Among Friends Social Club</u>

Key Tasks and Responsibilities: Direct Service (80%) The Community Service Worker –Work with senior participants of our Among Friends Social Club to increase community participation and create a sense of social connection. To ensure the programs and activities are meeting the needs of senior program participants, they will be actively involved in the monthly program activity planning sessions. The focus will be for the Community Service Worker to help plan a variety of creative and innovative leisure/recreation activities which are in adherence, with government and health guidelines. The employee will also assist with computer training to promote virtual participation. If possible, the Community Service Worker will help to connect senior members with appropriate services and resources in the community, to further enhance well-being.

Administrative tasks will include (20%): assisting with the program statistics, preparing the monthly program schedules, helping with members surveys, and updating membership information, and increasing awareness of the program.

<u>Community Service Worker - Building Bridges Program</u>

Key Tasks and Responsibilities: Direct Service (80%): Work with senior participants of our Building Bridges Program, (a one-to-one and small group social support program for socially isolated adults living with mental illness) to increase community participation. The employee will assist staff and volunteers in organizing small group and individual outings (depending on COVID-19 restrictions), phone check-ins and helping with access to virtual activities. The employee will also help with computer training to promote virtual participation.

Administrative tasks (20%): assisting with volunteer recruitment, updating information, and researching virtual programming. The employee will also assist with preparing a summer newsletter.

<u>Community Service Worker - Sharing & Caring Social Club</u>

Key Tasks and Responsibilities: Direct Service (80%): Work with senior participants of our Sharing and Social Club to increase community participation. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, participation will include virtual activities and assisting with a gradual return to programming, adhering to government and health guidelines. To ensure the programs and activities are meeting the needs of senior program participants, the Community Service Worker will be actively involved in the monthly program activity planning sessions. The employee will also help with computer training to promote virtual participation. If possible, the Community Service Worker will help to connect senior members with appropriate services and resources in the community, to further enhance well-being.

Administrative (20%): assisting with statistics, preparing the monthly program schedule, helping with member surveys, and updating membership information and increasing awareness of the program.
